First, the people see a problem and let their representative know.



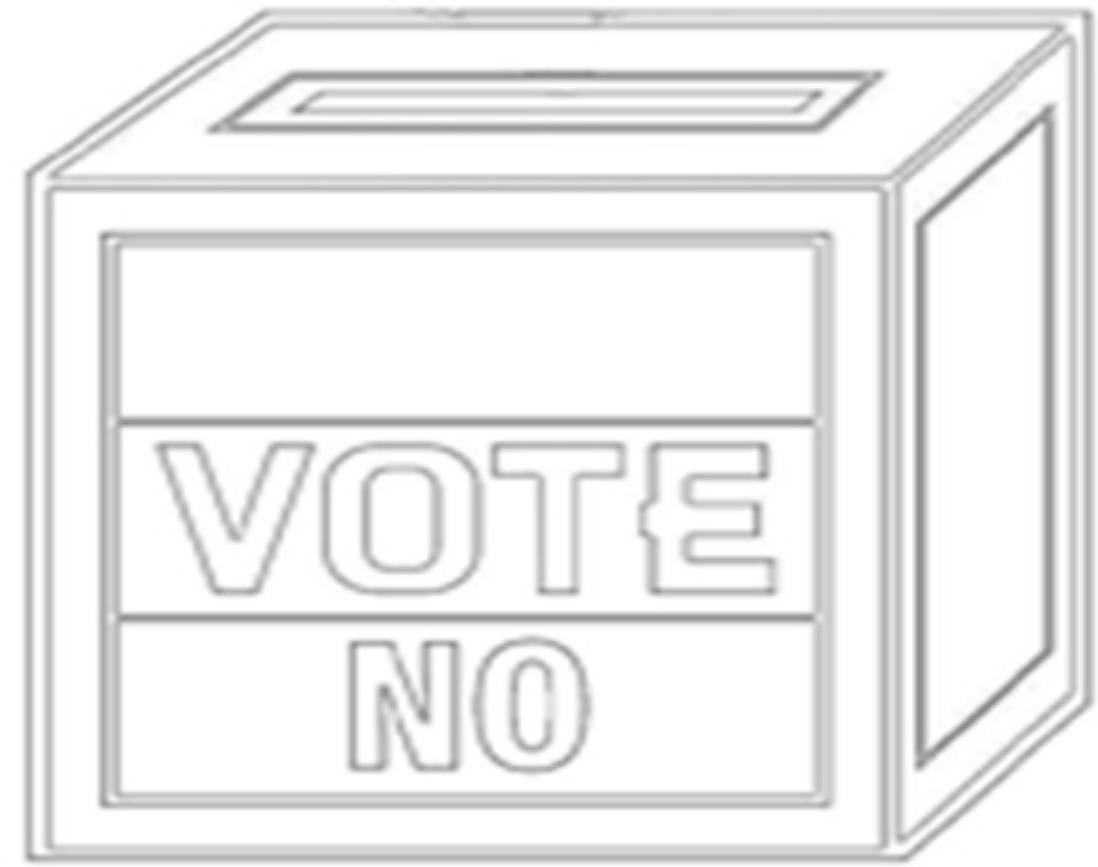
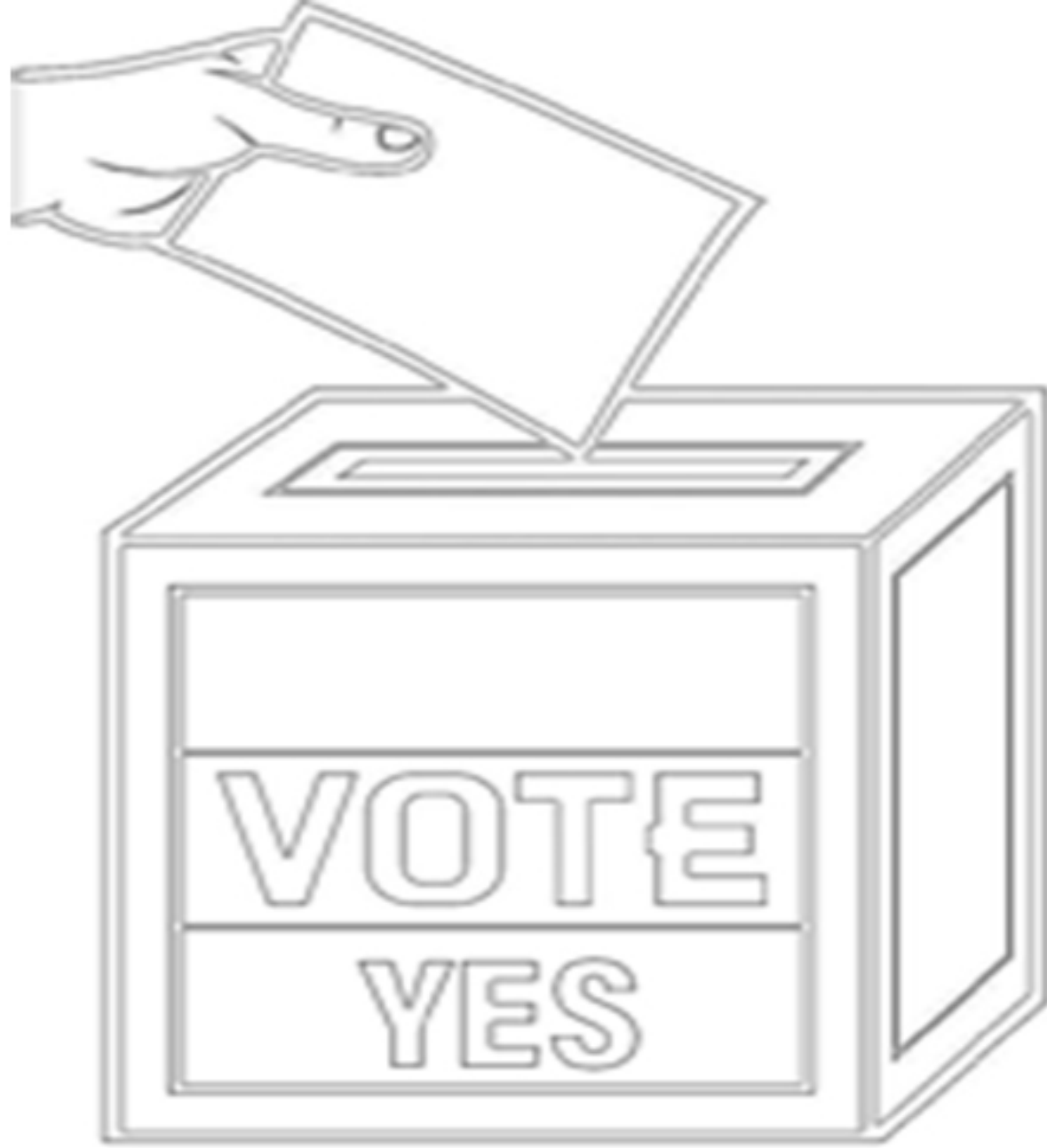
Once their representative hears about the problem, they write a bill to solve it!

If the Legislature votes to pass the bill, it gets sent to the Governor.

and the bill becomes a law!**
